| Segment | Pulling sounds in words apart to hear the number of sounds in order to spell, <br> e.g. f-or-k |
| Thrass <br> Chart | A chart to help with the Teaching of Handwriting, Reading and Spelling Skills |
| Letter <br> name rap | A song to identify all the letter names in the alphabet |
| Tumble <br> turn | A way of turning the thrass chart onto the other side. |
| Consonant | A speech sound that is not a vowel. |
| Vowel | A letter representing a vowel sound a e i o u |
| Robot <br> arms | An action to help segment all the sounds in a word, each time you hear a sound move <br> your arms like a robot. |
