**Dreidel** - A game played with a spinner

**Menorah** - Candle lit at Hanukkah with 8 branches

**Shabbat** - (Sabbath) Jewish holy day celebrated on a Saturday

**Star of David** - Jewish symbol

**Synagogue** - a holy place where Jews meet to worship

**Torah Scroll** - Jewish holy book written in Hebrew

### Key facts

Judaism is one of the oldest religions of the world and followers of Judaism are called Jews.

Shabbat is the Jewish Holy day. It starts on Friday evening and lasts until sunset on Saturday.

Jews worship in a Synagogue.

Hanukkah is a Jewish festival of light.

Teachers of the Jewish faith are called Rabbis.
