





| How much farmland is in the UK? | Nearly three-quarters of the land area of the United Kingdom is classified as farmland. |
| Where is Devon? | The county of Devon is in South West England. There are many dairy farms in Devon. |
| Where is Costa Rica? | Costa Rica is a country in Central America. |
| What is Costa Rica's climate like? | It has a climate that is hot and wet where bananas can grow. A banana farm is called a plantation. |

| Tropical | To do with the tropics. |


Maps (The Tropics and hot and cold places)
