



**Key Question: How does the geography of Kampong Ayer compare with the geography of where I live?**

Key Facts
We live in a town or village in the county of Suffolk, in the country of England, in the continent of Europe.
Kampong Ayer is a water village in the country of Brunei, on the island of Borneo in the continent of Asia.
In Suffolk houses are usually built of bricks with foundations built into the ground.
In Kampong Ayer houses are usually made of wood and built on stilts sunk into the river.
In Suffolk we experience changeable weather during the year including hot, cold, wet, dry, cloudy and snowy.
In Kampong Ayer the weather is hot and wet all year round.
Travel in Suffolk is usually by car, bus and bike on roads
Travel in Kampong Ayer is usually by boats on the rivers.
