Key Vocabulary

Paschal Candle - the large candle which is lit at Easter

Holy Spirit - the Third person in the Blessed Trinity

Saviour- A name given to Jesus , because he died and rose again to ' save' everyone from sin and death

Easter Vigil - the night before Easter Sunday, when Christians celebrate the death and resurrection of Jesus

Easter Sunday—The day when Jesus rose from the dead

Eternal Life - the life with God in heaven which Christians hope to have forever after they die

Heaven - where God is with Mary and the Saints

Fruits of the Spirit - gifts from God
