Pope Francis opened a Synod on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October on the future of the Catholic Church, where contentious topics will be discussed. The three-week General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops at the Vatican, has drawn Bishops from around the world to discuss issues including whether priests should be allowed to get married, if divorced and remarried Catholics should receive communion, whether women should be allowed to become deacons and how the church will handle matters around the LGBTQ+ community. The Pope has asked us all to pray that the Holy Spirit will guide those present at the Synod.
