Dear Parents,

Owls and Kingfishers have planned a trip to visit Banham Zoo on Wednesday 15th May. We are very excited to reinforce the work we are doing in class with this great trip to the zoo.

We will be leaving school around 9:30am and return by 2:30pm.

The weather can be unpredictable at this time of year so please ensure that the children are wearing suitable clothes. They will need to be in usual school uniform with comfortable shoes such as trainers. In addition, they will need a waterproof coat to ensure they can keep dry in the event of rain or a sunhat if the forecast is warm and sunny. Please apply sun-cream at home if required.

Children will also need a packed lunch in line with the school policy so no sweets, nuts or fizzy drinks please. The children will need to carry their water bottle and packed lunch with them all day so this will need to be in a rucksack that is easy for them to carry - carrier bags or lunch boxes on their own are not appropriate. **If you require your child to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please tick the relevant option on the consent form.**

You will need to consent to your child attending this trip and provide their packed lunch option, online via Scopay. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10 per child to help towards the cost of the trip. Permission and payment must be paid online via Scopay by no later than Friday 3rd May.

Thank you to the 'Friends' who have contributed towards the cost of the coach, without this our trip would not be possible.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please let us know well in advance, and by Friday 10th May at the very latest.

We will not have time to visit the shop during the trip, so please do not send any money in with your child.
